- I. **Meeting called to order at 5:05 pm**
- II. **Minutes:** Motion to approve: First – Angela Tilghman, Second – Edith Xicotencatl. Motion approved unanimously

- IV. **Action Items:**
 - a. **Review second parent survey:** Second parent survey showed that 100% of parents are satisfied or very satisfied with the preschool program. They also feel like their children are safe in the program. Areas that need improvement is parent interactions with each other, knowing the education and training of the staff and the discipline policy. In regards to the action plan to help in these areas, based on the results from the first survey, the preschool had a parent event called Game Day. Preschool families were invited to stay after dismissal to play games with their children, win prizes and enjoy snacks. The event took place on 5/20/2022. Nearly all families stayed for the event. On June 8, we are hosting another Family Read Along by Tia Chicha. The event will take place in the preschool yard at dismissal. There will be a reader, book give away, snacks and activities for families to do with their children.
 - b. **Universal Pre-Kindergarten:** Ms. Tilghman informed the Parent Advisory Council of Pacoima Charter School Universal Pre-kindergarten Plan. The plan allows for TK eligible families to decide if they would like their children to be in TK or preschool. TK will utilize the DRDP-K assessment and send out ASQ's at the beginning of the year. The TK class(es) will now be housed on the main campus. Extended hours will be available for both the preschool and transitional kindergarten. ELO-p for both programs will be from 7:00am to 8:00am and after dismissal until 5:00pm.
